RE.: Reinstatement of cap for Hunter Elementary

During the September 13, 2005 board meeting, the Board of Trustees placed an enrollment cap on Hunter Elementary and new students to the area were transported to Chief Joseph Elementary. This spring, during the kindergarten registration process, 160 new kindergarten students were enrolled which is 30 more students than enrolled in kindergarten last year. Approximately 800 students are currently enrolled at Hunter Elementary School, which was built to handle a capacity of 650 students. I am recommending that enrollment at Hunter be closed to all new students as of June 14, 2006. However, any family that has signed an Earnest Money Agreement on or before that date will be allowed to attend Hunter. I recommend all students be reassigned to Discovery Elementary effective as of July 11, 2006 and transportation will be provided.
