# Meridian Night School

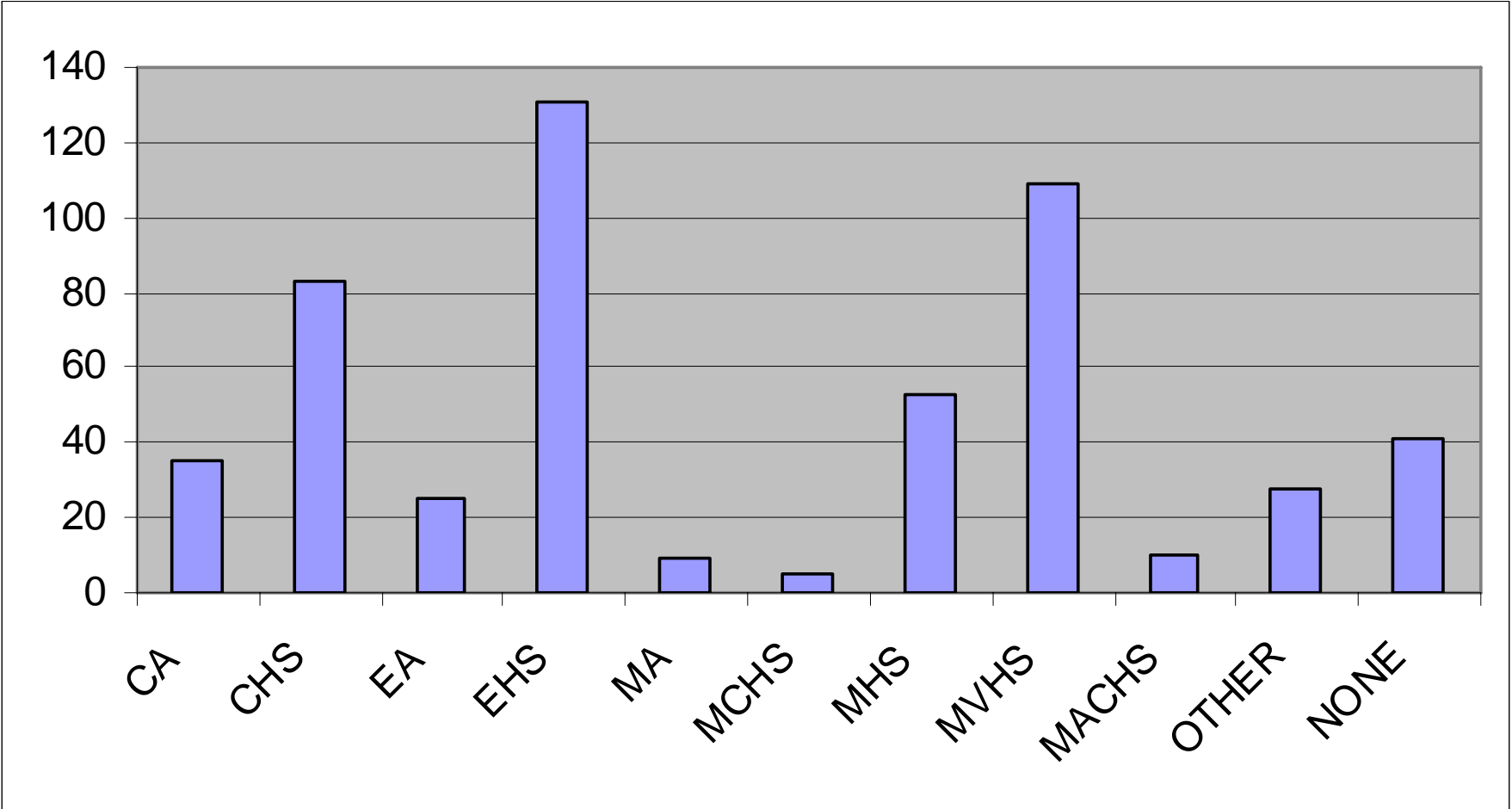
- Met Monday through Thursday 5:00-9:00
- Accepted any student eligible to enroll in high school
- Offered primarily core classes & PE

# At-risk Data

- Years prior to 2005 - 57% of enrolled students
- 2005-2006 - 57% of enrolled students
- 2006-2007 – 60% of enrolled students

# Credits Earned

- 2005-2006
  - 452 credits
  - 59 senior projects presented
- 2006-2007
  - 722 credits
  - 95 senior projects presented
  - 55 math credits – (T2=9, T3=14, T4=32)

- Predetermined class schedule
- New course offerings
  - Math
