7 Policy Title Student Truancy Code No. 501.40

10 A truancy occurs when a student is absent from any class without previous consent or
11 knowledge of the parents or an appropriate school official. Repeated truanancies may
12 result in expulsion from school.

13
14 Any pupil is habitually truant who, in the judgment of the board of trustees, repeatedly
15 has violated the attendance regulations, (for high schools and middle schools, specifics
16 are as outlined and published in student handbooks) or any child whose parent(s) or
17 guardian(s) failed or refused to cause such child to be instructed.

19 Any child under the age of sixteen (16) who accrues ten (10) unverified absences or
20 truanancies will be referred to the Board of Trustees pursuant to Idaho Code 33-206 which
21 states, in part, "a habitual truant is any public school pupil who, in the judgment of the
22 board of trustees, repeatedly has violated the attendance regulations established by the
23 board; or any child whose parents or guardians, or any of them, have failed or refused to
24 cause such child to be instructed as provided in section 33-202, Idaho Code, and the
25 child shall come under the purview of the juvenile corrections act if he or she is within
26 the age of compulsory attendance."

28 Principals, as the authorized representative of the Board, will submit documentation to
29 the Board regarding the excessive absences/truanancies by way of the Regional Directors.
30 Following the action of the Board, the Prosecuting Attorney in the county of the student's
31 residence will be notified of the violation by the school principal.
