7 Policy Title Building Attendance Zones Code No. 501.50

10 Building attendance zones shall be reviewed periodically and shall be established by the
11 board of trustees. The board will consider but will not be limited to the following
12 guidelines in establishing or revising attendance zones:

- 14 a. Neighborhood Proximity – The board will consider proximity in order to
15 promote neighborhood or “walk-in” schools and to minimize transportation
16 in general.
 - 17
 - 18 b. Geographic Areas – Geographic areas should be based on easily
19 identified and understood geographical features whenever possible.
 - 20
 - 21 c. Maximum Enrollment Guidelines – The District may limit the enrollment of
22 any school, in order to provide the best educational environment.
 - 23
 - 24 d. Balancing of Enrollment – Enrollments should not be excessive in any
25 particular school when capacity is available at another location.
 - 26
 - 27 e. Students with disabilities – The special needs of students with disabilities
28 will be considered in establishing attendance zones.
 - 29
 - 30 f. Economics – The overall economics of the district’s operation should
31 always be considered.
 - 32
 - 33 g. Special Circumstances – Unforeseen, special circumstances relating to
34 any particular zone revision will also be considered.
 - 35
 - 36 h. The above considerations are not necessarily listed in order of priority.
